Training Resources

Your newly adopted dog will take some time to settle in. All pets, whether a puppy or adult, need time and patience to fit into a new home. There is something we use in rescue called the **3-3-3 Rule**. In the first three days, your new pet may be overwhelmed with his new surroundings. He may not eat, drink, defecate, or be himself. After three weeks, he's starting to settle in, feeling more comfortable, and realizing this just might be his home. He lets his guard down and may start showing his real personality for good or not so good. After three months, your pet is starting to feel comfortable in his home. You have built trust and a true bond.

In order to assist with this trust and bond, Harvey's Hope Animal Rescue requires basic obedience training for all adopted pets, regardless of age.
